

Brimfield State Forest Trails, Brimfield

Brimfield State Forest has over 18 formal, blazed trails and roads available for hiking, walking, horseback riding, mountain biking, skiing and fishing. The roads are popular for equestrian use. Dean Pond Recreation Area has a pavilion, comfort station, beach and picnic facilities.

Location:	Traveling west from Brimfield Center on Route 20, turn left onto Monson Rd. and left onto Dean Rd. to Park entrance will be in 2 miles.
Trail Type:	Paved and off-road trails
Length/Difficulty:	20 miles; Easy to moderate. Most are easy, but trails are rutty, not maintained
Permitted Uses:	Hiking, walking, bicycling, mountain biking, skiing (cross- country), horseback riding, picnicking
Parking:	One designated parking area located at the Dean Pond Recreation Area
Facilities:	Restrooms and picnic shelters
