Connecticut River Walk and Bikeway, Agawam, Chicopee, Springfield, and West Springfield

The Connecticut River Walk and Bikeway follows the east bank of the river in Springfield and the west bank in Agawam. The 1.7-mile portion in Agawam and the 3.7 mile stretch in Springfield offer great vistas and smooth travel along the river. The Agawam River Walk Loop is a system of connected sidewalks and bike lanes along River Rd. to Main St. to School St. The length of this loop is 5 miles.
