

Columbia Greenway Rail Trail, Westfield

The Columbia Greenway Rail Trail is a multi-modal linear park, which follows the route of a former railroad (and one-time Northampton, MA to New Haven, CT canal). Stretching from Southwick to the Great (Westfield) River Bridge, the Columbia Greenway Rail Trail traverses downtown Westfield on a mostly elevated line, with bridge crossings of all downtown streets with one surface street crossing.

Permitted Uses:	Biking, inline skating, wheelchair accessible, walking, cross country skiing
Parking:	A parking lot is available behind the Shaker Farms Country Club (866 Shaker Road, Westfield).
