

Goat Rock Trail, Hampden

The 35-acre Goat Rock Conservation Area connects two town parks via a popular hiking trail called the Goat Rock Ridge Trail, which runs along the Wilbraham Mountain ridge for a little over a mile. There are two scenic vistas, Lookout Point at the east end of the trail and the historic Goat Rock at the west end.

Trail Type:	Unpaved hiking trail
Length/Difficulty:	1 mile; Moderate
Permitted Uses:	Walking, hiking, and bird watching
Parking:	Available at both locations.
