

Knightville Dam and Reservoir Trails, Huntington

The Knightville Dam and Reservoir area are in Huntington along the East Branch of the Westfield River. Former cart roads and a marked woodland trail follow the river and explore the hillsides of the 2,430 undeveloped acres.

Location:	From Huntington center, take Route 112 north 4 miles to Knightville Dam Rd.
Trail Type:	2 old cart roads that parallel each side of the river and 1 wooded trail
Length/Difficulty:	9 miles; Easy to moderate
Permitted Uses:	Hiking, snowmobiling, mountain biking, cross country skiing, and picnicking
Parking:	3 parking areas available near dam off Knightville Dam Rd.; 2 in the picnic area and 1 at the Ranger Station; parking also on the west side of the river at the end of Knightville Wildlife Area Rd.
Facilities:	Picnic area, restrooms, and campground
