McDonald Nature Preserve Trails, Wilbraham

Though only 29 acres in size, the McDonald Nature Preserve lies adjacent to other conservation lands, including the White Cedar Swamp. Hiking trails allow for an enjoyable walk from the McDonald Nature Preserve to Nine Mile Pond, or to the Wilbraham Middle School. From the main trail, Alton's Way, there are many side trails that can make for a longer hike through the hardwood forests and wetlands. areas.

the Wilbraham Middle School.
