

Mount Tom State Reservation Trails, Holyoke and Easthampton

Mount Tom Reservation boasts fantastic views of the Connecticut River Valley, the Berkshire Mountains to the west and the Pelham Hills to the east. The New England National Scenic Trail passes through the Reservation, entering from the southwest. The Reservation offers 20 miles of formal, blazed, off-road trails (approximately 15 trails in total) in its 2,082 acre facility.

Location:	Entrances on Route 141 in Easthampton and Route 5 in Holyoke
Trail Type:	Formal, blazed, off-road trails
Length/Difficulty:	20 miles, involving 15 trails, Easy to strenuous
Permitted Uses:	Hiking, walking, snowshoeing, cross-country skiing, and picnicking.
Parking:	7 designated parking areas within Reservation
Facilities:	Restrooms, picnic areas, pavilion, visitor's center
