Noble View Outdoor Center Trails, Russell

A 358-acre Appalachian Mountain Club property, Noble View offers great views of the Pioneer Valley. The 35 miles of trails wind through woodlands and abandoned farm fields, passing brooks, stone walls, cellar holes, and diverse habitats, including an old growth hemlock stand.

Location:	From Route 20, take Route 23 south; turn left on General Knox Rd., and then right on South Quarter Rd.; entrance will be on left after 1.2 miles.
