

Norcross Wildlife Sanctuary Trails, Wales

The Norcross Wildlife Sanctuary comprises approximately 8,000 acres of wood hills, lakes, and streams. The gardens along the walking trail represent habitats found throughout New England, and include wildflower gardens and two natural history museums. The Sanctuary is closed on Sundays.

Location:	From Route 32 in Monson, turn on Wales Road, right at the fork. After entering Wales in approximately 3 miles, go ½ mile and take a right onto Peck Road. Entrance on the left.
Trail Type:	Marked walking trails
Length/Difficulty:	2 miles; Easy
Permitted Uses:	Walking, hiking, bird watching, picnicking
Parking:	Available at the Main Administration Building. Please register when arriving.
