

Petticoat Hill Trail, Williamsburg

Petticoat Hill Trail, managed by The Trustees of Reservations, offers 1.5 miles of trails in a 60-acre property. Climb through a restored forest that boasts a rich variety of hardwood species, passing stone walls and cellar holes that reveal the hill's agricultural past.

Location:	From Route 9 in Williamsburg Center, turn left onto Petticoat Hill Rd. and follow 0.2 miles to entrance on left.
Trail Type:	Marked off paths
Length/Difficulty:	1.5 miles; Strenuous in most parts
Permitted Uses:	Hiking, walking, bird watching, cross-country skiing, and picnicking; mountain biking is not allowed and dogs must be kept on a leash.
Parking:	Designated parking for up to 2 cars
Facilities:	Picnic areas
