

Road's End Wildlife Sanctuary Trail, Worthington

Mass Audubon's 157-acre Road's End Wildlife Sanctuary offers a short 1-mile loop trail.. The sanctuary features a diverse landscape of fields, forest, and wetlands and runs along the height of a long ridge and offers occasional views of the surrounding Berkshire Hills.

Location:	From Route 112 in Worthington, go to the end of Corbett Road.
Trail Type:	Marked off-road
Length/Difficulty:	Approximately 1 mile; Easy to moderate
Permitted Uses:	Hiking, walking, snowshoeing, picnicking
Parking:	Seasonal parking at the end of the road
