

## Robinson State Park Trails, Agawam

Robinson State Park has approximately 20 miles of trails, many of which provide scenic views of the Westfield River. This includes a view to the 17-acre island west of the picturesque falls at Mittineague.

<b>Location:</b>	Off North St, in Agawam.
<b>Trail Type:</b>	Paved and unpaved sections of marked walking trail
<b>Length/Difficulty:</b>	20 miles (approx.); Easy to moderate
<b>Permitted Uses:</b>	Hiking, jogging, picnicking, biking, and cross-country skiing
<b>Parking:</b>	At North St. entrance
<b>Facilities:</b>	Accessible bathrooms and picnic areas
