

Southwick Rail Trail, Southwick

The six-mile section of trail in Southwick, Massachusetts, is very scenic and follows the former New Haven to Northampton canal and connects to the Farmington Canal Heritage Trail to the south. A flat, smooth paved asphalt surface makes the trail popular with cyclists.

Location:	From College Highway (Route 10) travel east on route 168 to Miller St. parking area
Trail Type:	Paved asphalt
Length/Difficulty:	7 miles; Easy
Permitted Uses:	Hiking, biking, and in-line skating
